**CARBON REDUCTION POLICY STATEMENT FOR MURTALA MUHAMMED INTERNATIONAL  
AIRPORT (MMIA)**

1. Murtala Muhammed International Airport (MMIA) is one of the twenty-two (22) commercial airports operated by the Federal Airports Authority of Nigeria (FAAN). MMIA is Nigeria's busiest airport, geographically located on coordinates 6.5818<sup>0</sup> N and 3.3211<sup>0</sup> E.
2. FAAN, as the parastatal of government having the mandate to operate airports within the Nigeria State, is committed to carbon emission reduction based on the understanding of the potential impacts our operations have on the environment, and the present challenges of global warming and climate change to which our industry is a contributor.
3. To achieve our long-term goal of net-zero emissions, FAAN is committed to:
  - i. Capacity building, through trainings and retraining of staff members involved in emission management.
  - ii. Improvement on our data collection process to understand, identify, and control our operational activities that generate carbon emission.
  - iii. Consistent monitoring and evaluation of our carbon emission data and developing specific mitigative measures in line with the ACI- Airport Carbon Accreditation programme.
  - iv. Setting realistic carbon reduction targets and implementing the following measures to reduce our carbon footprint.
4. We will ensure implementation of these policy measures as part of our commitment to achieving and maintaining sustainable airport environment. The policy will be reviewed every two years to meet current changes in global environmental sustainability.
