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This emissions report for Murtala Muhammed International Airport, year 2024, was prepared using Version 7.0 of the Airport Carbon Emission Reporting Tool (ACERT) according to the Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA) programme. The report covers Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions from the airport during the year being reported. The total carbon emissions, from Scope 1 and Scope 2, for the year (2024) is 6,366.2 tCO_{2e} as calculated by ACERT 7.0 Version. Scope 1 emissions accounted for 4,802.2 tCO_{2e} while Scope 2 emissions accounted for 1,564.0 tCO_{2e}

Murtala Muhammed International Airport (MMIA) is operated by the Federal Airports Authority of Nigeria (FAAN). MMIA is strategically located in the Southwestern region of Nigeria on Longitude 6.5818° N and Latitude 3.3211° E of the equator. FAAN targets a 20% reduction in Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions of the airport by year 2030 with year 2019 as the base year.

This report is part of our continuous voluntary decarbonisation efforts as an organisation that is committed to achieving sustainable airport operations through reporting, managing and reducing the emissions with the airport boundary, and by engaging our stakeholders toward reduction of our Scope 3 emissions.
